

The following campus repeat policy goes into effect at the start of the Spring 2003 semester:

1. A maximum of 15 semester units of CSUN coursework may be repeated for grade replacement.
2. Repeats for grade replacement are limited to grades of "C-" or lower.
3. Only one repeat per course is permitted for grade replacement.
4. Students attempting to enroll in the same course for third or subsequent time must be approved by the associate dean of the college of the course of face administrative withdrawal from the course by the end of the third week. (This does not apply to those courses in which repeated enrollments are required or allowed.)
5. When a course is repeated for grade replacement, the subsequent enrollment must be on the same basis of grading as the first. The higher of the two grades is counted in the student's grade point average, and the lower grade is replaced in the GPA computation. However both grades appear on the student's permanent record (transcript).
6. Grades assigned as part of disciplinary procedures may not be replaced by repeating them.
7. Students should be aware that other institutions' admission committees - i.e. medical schools, law schools, or other graduate programs - might use the original grades in their own grade point computations.
